OUR MISSION

Bay Scholars promotes a life-altering experience connecting promising youth with transformative educational opportunities at Bay Area Catholic college prep high schools.

Originally started over ten years ago as a privately funded scholarship organization focused in San Francisco, Bay Scholars has grown to address issues of education equity and access throughout the Bay Area. Our Scholars benefit from a four-year \$14,000 scholarship and access to transformative college prep educational communities, as well as programming designed to support their matriculation to college. Currently, Bay Scholars is supporting 500 Scholars at 13 Bay Area schools, serving San Francisco, Alameda, Contra Costa, San Mateo, and Santa Clara counties. Since its founding, Bay Scholars has awarded over \$8.5 million in scholarships and plans to distribute over \$1.5 million per school year moving forward.

As Bay Scholars continues to grow, the heart of our mission remains focused on partnering with local college prep high schools to create pathways to colleges and universities for underserved and low-income students across the Bay Area.
